## New records for the Tuscan Airport System: July 2024 is the best month ever Passengers exceeded the 5 million mark for the first time already in the first seven months of the year

*Florence, August 5, 2024* – The **Tuscan Airport System** has reached a new historical record. July 2024 is the month with the highest number of passengers overall transiting through the airports of Florence and Pisa. With almost 1 million passengers (999.9 thousand passengers to be precise), the Tuscan Airport System recorded a growth of 5.5% compared to the same month in 2023. This result was determined by the increase in the number of commercial passenger flights (+1.4%) and the load factor of scheduled flights, which reached 88.1%, an increase of 1.9 percentage points.

The Tuscan Airport System reached another important milestone, surpassing 5 million passengers by the end of the first seven months of 2024, with a total of 5.1 million passengers and a 12.4% improvement over the same period in 2023.

In July, **Florence's Amerigo Vespucci Airport** welcomed 350,000 passengers, marking a +2.8% increase over the same month in 2023 and thus setting a new record for the month of July. This result is mainly due to the improvement in the load factor, which reached 84.3% (+3 percentage points), largely offsetting the 2.4% drop in the number of commercial passenger flights. International traffic continues to lead the growth with an increase of 3.5%, while domestic traffic is basically in line (-0.4%) with last year. The most popular destinations served by scheduled flights were Paris, London, Amsterdam, Rome and Barcelona.

Thanks to this positive trend, Florence airport has already surpassed the 2 million passenger threshold at the end of the first seven months of 2024, recording an overall growth of +18.1% compared to the same period in 2023.

**Pisa's Galileo Galilei Airport** also achieved a record-breaking July 2024 with the best month ever in terms of passenger traffic. In fact, 650 thousand passengers transited through the Pisa airport with a growth of +7.0% compared to the same month in 2023. This result stemmed from the improvement in the number of commercial passenger flights (+4.6%) and the load factor, which stood at 90.3% (+1.1 percentage points compared to 2023). Both international (+7.2%) and domestic (+6.3%) traffic grew during the month. The favourite destinations in July 2024 were London, Tirana, Palermo, Paris and Catania.

With these results, Pisa airport reaches its all-time high in terms of total passengers transited in the first seven months of the year, reaching 3.1 million and marking a +9.0% compared to the same period in 2023.
