

PRESS RELEASE**RECORD FEBRUARY FOR THE TUSCAN AIRPORT SYSTEM THE THRESHOLD OF 500,000 PASSENGERS EXCEEDED FOR THE FIRST TIME**

Florence, March 5, 2025 – The **Tuscan Airport System** exceeds the 500,000 passenger threshold for the first time in the month of February. In fact, 506,000 passengers passed through the airports of Florence and Pisa, with an **increase of 14.1%** over 2024 and a solid growth in both domestic (+21.9%) and international (+11.8%) traffic. Thanks to the monthly records recorded in the first two months of the year, the Tuscan Airport System reached 992,000 passengers in transit overall, with a 9.8% growth on 2024.

February was a record month for **Florence's 'Amerigo Vespucci' airport**, which exceeded the 200,000-passenger mark for the first time in February, an **increase of 6.0%** compared to February 2024. During the month, there was significant growth in domestic traffic (+11.8%) and international traffic (+5.0%). Paris confirmed itself as the preferred route for travellers departing from Florence, followed by London, Barcelona, Rome and Amsterdam. With the monthly records recorded in the first two months of the year, Florence airport reaches 405,000 passengers, marking a growth of 4.7% compared to the same period in 2024.

Pisa's 'Galileo Galilei' airport marks the best February ever, exceeding 300,000 passengers for the first time and with a strong **growth of 20.4%** over the same month in 2024. Both traffic segments, international and domestic, grew by 18.1% and 25.5% respectively. The ranking of passengers' favourite destinations at Pisa airport sees London in first place, followed by Tirana, Palermo, Catania and Paris. Pisa airport, with 587,000 passengers in the first two months of the year, marks the best result ever for the period, with an increase of 13.6% over the first two months of 2024.

(managing company of the Florence A. Vespucci airport) and SAT - Società Aeroporto Toscano S.p.A. (managing company of the Pisa G. The Tuscan Airport System is one of the most important in Italy and is a driver of local economic development in one of the world's best known and most loved regions.
